All species will be true to name and all plants will leave the nursery in healthy condition. The merchandise becomes your responsibility when you pick it up or we have delivered it to the carrier. In case of loss or damage in transit, you must file claim with the carrier. If you suspect the plants were harmed, we advise that you contact the carrier before you open it. If your plants arrive in poor condition, we must be notified in writing within 3 days in order to consider a claim. We are not responsible for damage due to conditions or events beyond our control including, but not limited to, the care of the plants provided by the customer and the suitability of the site. We do not guarantee that the plants will establish and or survive on the customer's chosen site.

Our specialty is providing native plants original to sources within 100 miles of the Twin Cities Metro area of Minnesota. We may, due to market conditions, have to provide plants from sources farther away. In all cases we will choose the closest source available and all plants will be hardy and suitable to the general climate of the Twin Cities Metropolitan area. In some cases, plants native to North America but not strictly to Minnesota are used in native plantings either because their original range was near, the habitats similar or their landscape utility has led them to be desired. The mark "§" has been placed after the species name in the list to denote this. No other guarantee is expressed or implied.

GENERAL

Please send written orders or stock availability requests by fax or e-mail whenever possible. Phone calls are OK if you are on a tight schedule but verbal requests do have greater potential for errors. We will acknowledge your request as soon as possible, also preferably by fax or e-mail. There are no minimum purchase requirements. You can mix or match species or varieties to receive quantity discounts, but only within plant size categories. For example, not mixing between 6 pack grasses and 3 1/2" pot forbs. Plant size and species availability is subject to season, weather, and supply. Please list a few alternate choices. If unable to substitute, we will adjust balance due and/or make refund. We prefer not to make backorders.

Please call for current hours. Our season usually runs from late April through October, although weather conditions may allow staying open later in the fall. Orders may be placed anytime during the entire calendar year. We are closed major holidays. Plants begin to be available in late April. However, many species may not be available until later.

TERMS

We accept cash, checks, Visa, American Express and Mastercard for payment. A \$30.00 fee will be charged on each returned check.
