# Terms and Conditions - Retail

## GENERAL

Please send written orders or stock availability requests by e-mail whenever possible. Phone calls are OK but verbal requests do have greater potential for errors. We will acknowledge your request as soon as possible, also preferably by e-mail. There are no minimum purchase requirements. You can mix or match species or varieties to receive quantity discounts, but only within plant size categories. For example, not mixing between 6 pack grasses and 3 1/2" pot forbs. Plant size and species availability is subject to season, weather, and supply. Please list a few alternate choices. If unable to substitute, we will adjust balance due and/or make refund. We prefer not to make backorders.

Normal business hours are Tuesday – Sunday 12-5; Closed Mondays and Major Holidays. Please call for current hours. Our season usually runs from late April through October, although weather conditions may allow staying open later in the fall. Orders may be placed anytime during the entire calendar year. Plants begin to be available in late April. However, many species may not be available until later.

## PRICES

All prices are listed F. O. B. our Saint Croix Valley, MN nursery. Prices, rates and discounts are based upon present market conditions and are subject to change without notice.

## TERMS

Orders can only be placed by credit card. For in-store purchases we accept cash, checks, Discover, American Express, Visa and Mastercard for payment. A \$30.00 fee will be charged on each returned check.

## ORDERS

Upon acceptance of the order, the customer's credit card will be charged for 50% of the total (excluding shipping and sales tax) as a non-refundable deposit. This amount will be credited to the total invoice at the time the plants are picked up or shipped and the remaining balance will be charged to the customer's credit card at that time. We prefer orders be picked up at the St. Croix nursery whenever possible.

If you prefer, we will arrange delivery by local courier. We need the ship-to address and date desired. It is important that someone be at the delivery location to receive delivery and begin taking care of the plants. Delivery and handling cost will be extra and is dependent upon size of the order and specific destination. Courier service requires at least one day's notice. Please contact us with sufficient notice to make arrangements. We reserve the right to delay shipping during cold or hot weather. If you pick up your plants be sure to bring suitable coverings to protect the plants during your drive home.

It is the customer's responsibility to make arrangements with us should they desire to delay picking up or shipping the order. In this case, we reserve the right to cancel the order. The 50% deposit will be forfeited as a cancellation / restocking fee.

## GUARANTEE

All species will be true to name and all plants will leave the nursery in healthy condition. The merchandise becomes your responsibility when you pick it up or we have delivered it to the carrier. In case of loss or damage in transit, you must file claim with the carrier immediately. For any other issues regarding the order we must be notified in writing within 3 business days of delivery to consider a claim. We are not responsible for damage due to conditions or events beyond our control including, but not limited to, the care of the plants provided by the customer and the suitability of the site. We do not guarantee that the plants will establish and or survive on the customer's chosen site.

Our specialty is providing native plants original to sources within 100 miles of the Twin Cities Metro area of Minnesota. We may, due to market conditions, have to provide plants from sources farther away. In all cases we will choose the closest source available and all plants will be hardy and suitable to the general climate of the Twin Cities Metropolitan area. In some cases, plants native to North America but not strictly to Minnesota are used in native plantings either because their original range was near, the habitats similar or their landscape utility has led them to be desired. The mark "A" has been placed after the species name in the list to denote this. No other guarantee is expressed or implied.

## CONTAINER SIZES

**6-Packs:** are 2.25" deep, 1.5" wide, 2.25" long. The soil volume is 3.5 fl oz (106 ml). 8 6-Packs per tray.

**3.5 Inch Pots:** are 3.75" deep, 3.5" wide. The soil volume is 16 fl. Oz (474 ml). 18 Pots per tray.

**#1 Square pots:** are 6.5" deep, 6" across. The soil volume is 93 fl. oz (2,750 ml) 8 Pots per tray.

**#2 Round pots:** are 8.0" deep, 8.25" across.
